A05:1.a	<p>I The aim for the ILS (Integrated Logistic Support) program is to optimize cost for maintaining and preserving the performance of the Trainset during it's Lifetime, in order to increase the return of investments and optimize LCC.</p> <p>The ILS program will, in an integrated way, coordinate the elements of ILS (for example, Reliability, Availability, Maintainability, Spare supply, storage, transport, Training and Documentation, among others).</p> <p>Norske tog will not specify any standard for the ILS process, but the S3000L standard and SX000i can be referred to as good practice.</p>
